The musical talent of Maestro Vladimir Vais brought him to the celebrated St Petersburg Conservatoire where he obtained three Performing Art degrees: as a pianist, composer and conductor.

He conducted the legendary Bolshoi Theatre for over 11 years and was equally successful in the field of symphonic music. He conducted all major symphony orchestras of the former USSR and toured the USA, Europe and Australasia at the invitation of symphony orchestras, opera and ballet companies.

In Australia Maestro Vais has conducted the Melbourne, West Australian, Adelaide and Queensland Symphony orchestras and has performed with Roger Woodward, Ronald Farren-Price, Dene Olding, Joan Carden, Rosamund Illing, David Mc Allister, Adam Marchant, Steven Heathcote and others.

At present Maestro Vladimir Vais is Musical Director of the Puccini Festival Australia and the Australia Opera Academy.
